Dear Parent/Carers,

I am writing to provide some further information with respect to the Centre Assessed Grading Process for this year.

On 6th January 2021, the government confirmed that in summer 2021, students taking GCSE, AS and A levels regulated by Ofqual, should be awarded grades based on an assessment by their teachers.

Teachers can use a variety of evidence to determine grades from across the course. When determining the grade, teachers should reflect the standard at which the student is performing now, not their potential.



Teachers and schools have been given until 18th June to submit the grades for students. We will be continuing to assess students up until the 11th June, in the subjects that they are studying. The period from the 11th June until the 18th June will be used for internal moderation of student work.

Although there is no requirement for Year 13 students to continue to attend from the 11th June all students will need to be available to come into school between the 11th and 18th June should moderation indicate a need for this.
