

Expectations

At Hanson Sixth Form, we pride ourselves on the high expectations we set for our students. We strongly value and place enormous emphasis on the partnership between school, parent's and carers, and students alike. With this in mind, we insist on all our stakeholders working to the very best of their ability, dedicating themselves to their studies not only in lessons but also outside of lessons to complement and reinforce their learning. We know from experience that if students work with a professional and consistent approach, they will achieve positive and aspirational outcomes, setting themselves up for an outstanding future.

Our expectations are as follows and are non-negotiable:

- Student's attendance must be at 95% or above at all times.
- Students must be punctual to school in the morning. They should arrive by 8.20am at the latest ready to be in the form room by 8.30am.
- Students must be punctual to every lesson. **IT IS NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SIXTH FORM TEAM TO NAG YOUR CHILD TO GET TO THEIR LESSON ON TIME.** Students should view punctuality as a vital quality that will eventually be mirrored in the workplace.
- Students are only permitted to go out of school at lunchtime between 12.20pm and 12.50pm. If students are late, they will not be permitted to come back into school and this will be marked as an unauthorised absence.
- Students must not order food or drink from external agencies to the front gate.
- Do not wear outdoor coats anywhere in the school (aside from the common room).
- Do not have mobile phones or ear pods/phones visible anywhere in the school (aside from the common room).
- Students must wear their lanyards at all times.
- Be polite and courteous to each other, all members of staff and visitors to the school.
- Act as a role model to each other and to all other Hanson students in Years 7-11.
- When students have a timetabled "study period" they must work quietly in the study areas and are not permitted to socialise in the common room.
