Day	Date & time	Event
Tuesday	7 th September 2021 6.00pm	Parents transition evening - Parents and students will have an opportunity to meet the Sixth Form team & their form tutor. Expectations and plans for Year 12 & 13 and post Year 13 will be presented.
Wednesday	8 th September 2021 8.20am	Induction day. All students must attend
Monday	27 th September 2021	Go Ape – Team building day (all of Year 12)
Thursday	14 th October 2021	Yorkshire Skills Show (for Level 2 students only) - This event brings students face-to-face with employers, training providers, colleges, universities and professional bodies. The event will raise aspirations, motivate and inspire the students using hands-on demonstrations and activities.
Wednesday	17 th November 2021 6.00pm	Parents Destinations Evening & fair - Students and parents will be invited to a Destinations evening to explore the different pathways and destinations students have been introduced to. Across the evening, there will be interactive workshops and a showcase fair where parents and students can speak to a range of Universities, training providers and employers.
Friday	19 th November 2021	University taster-day (Level 3 students only) - Students will visit a university for the day and find out more about life at university, how to apply and have the opportunity to tour a campus. This visit will give students the chance to meet departmental staff and get hands-on experience of the facilities. It can provide students with important insight into how the university or college works. Experiences such as this can also be used to support personal statements and the application process.
Thursday	10 th March 2022 4.30pm – 7.00pm	Parent Consultation Evening – an opportunity to discuss your child's attainment and progress with their subject teachers and to discuss any concerns or questions with the sixth form team. It is an opportunity to help students with the process of identifying appropriate next steps with regards destination planning. A range of HE and apprenticeship providers will also be present to speak to parents if required.
Wednesday	23 rd March 2022	Mock interviews - This important component of our Destinations Programme introduces students to the process of preparing for a potentially daunting interview. It brings students face to face with employers and universities in a supportive environment to explore their skills, knowledge and attributes.
Friday	8 th April 2022	HE & Destinations day - Students will take part in a series of workshops and talks delivered by Higher Education providers. These workshops will range from personal statement writing, how to navigate UCAS & life as a student.
