January 2022 Arrangements: updated

Happy New Year. I hope you all had a very safe, restful and enjoyable Christmas break. The government has updated its guidance for schools to ensure face-to-face teaching can be maintained and help avoid other contingency measures. The current advice has not changed greatly but does ask that **all secondary aged students now wear face coverings in lessons as well as on corridors and in communal areas** (unless exempt).

As per our previous communication in December, students will be offered one Lateral Flow Test (LFD) on return to school this week. To allow for this, we have planned a staggered start and remote learning as detailed below for each year group. Please note students will only be tested in school if you have previously given consent.

Students attending for LFD do not need to wear school uniform, but should bring their lanyard (where possible). Students should plan to attend school for face-to-face lessons in full school uniform the following day (as outlined below) unless they test LFD positive. **Students will only be contacted if their LFD is positive.**

Students should access their normal timetabled lessons via Microsoft Teams until their face-to-face teaching resumes.
