Dear Parents/Carers

I would like to thank you for your warm welcome and support this term. Please find arrangements for the end of term and the start of the new term within this letter and on our school website.

School closes Friday 22nd July 2022 at 12.20pm. Grab bags will be available to students in receipt of free school meals as they leave site. We will open again to students Wednesday 7th September 2022. Please note Monday 5th September and Tuesday 6th September are staff training days.

Thank you for engaging in the new school day consultation. I am pleased to confirm that from September school will start for all students at 8.25am and finish at 2.30pm, although we have a range of extra curricular and enrichment activities for students 2.30-3.30pm everyday. Please see timings of the school day below.

Arrangements for the beginning of next academic year:

Wednesday 7th September

- Year 7, Year 11 and Year 12 students will start the new term. We would ask that Year 11 students arrive at school by 8.25am and go straight to the hall for assembly. Year 7 students should arrive at school at 9.30am and go straight to the main hall for assembly. Year 12 students should arrive at 8.25am and go straight to the Sixth Form Common Room.

Thursday 8th September

- Year 7 should arrive by 8.25am and go straight to lessons
- Year 8 should arrive at 9.15am and go straight to the main hall for assembly at 9.30am
- Year 9 should arrive at 9.50am and go straight to the main hall for assembly at 10.10am
- Year 10 should arrive at 8.25am and go straight to the main hall for assembly at 8.30am
- Year 11 should arrive by 8.25am and go straight to lessons
- Year 12 should arrive by 8.25am and go straight to lessons
- Year 13 should arrive at 8.25am and go straight to the Lecture Theatre for assembly at 8.30am
- Lessons will begin period 1 for Year 7, 11 and 12, period 2 for Year 10 and 13 and period 3 for Year 8 and 9 all. Students need to be equipped for the school day. Year 8-10 students are not required to bring their PE kit Thursday 8th September. Year 7 and 11 are required to bring their PE kit Thursday 8th September if they have PE timetabled that day.

Uniform

Delta Academies Trust have offered all Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 students a **free school uniform and PE kit for September 2022**. Please note current Year 10 students moving into Year 11 in September will continue to wear Hanson uniform and Hanson PE kit as they only have one year left at school.

Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 Delta uniform pack for September 2022 will include:

- **1 Delta blazer**
- **1 twin pack of Delta long sleeved shirts/blouses**
- **1 pair of Delta trousers or a skirt***
- **1 pair of Delta PE shorts or Delta PE trackpants**
- **1 Delta PE polo shirt**
- **1 Delta long sleeved sports top**
- **1 pair of PE socks**
- **1 Delta clip on tie**

*Skirts must be worn with 60 denier black tights (minimum).

If you ordered a new Delta uniform, they can be collected from school reception anytime Tuesday 30th August and Friday 2nd September (between 8.30am and 2.30pm). An adult will need to sign to collect the new uniform. Alternatively, school opens to staff Monday 5th September and any remaining uniforms can be collected Monday 5th September or Tuesday 6th September (between 8am and 3.00pm). The uniform supplier will enclose returns information in each pack.

Year 11

Hanson blazers and PE kit can only be purchased from The Uniform Shop (Bradford) and Whitakers (formerly Henry Smiths Shipley). All other items can be purchased from a variety of different uniform stockist including Natasha's and Rawcliffes. Alternatively, Year 11 students can purchase Delta uniform from SPT Uniforms if they would like to wear the new Delta uniform <https://www.sptuniforms.co.uk/product-category/hanson-academy/> Please note that only black tailored trousers will be permitted (no leggings, stretch pants or jeans will be allowed) or students can opt to wear a black Delta skirt (no other variations will be allowed).

All students will also require a school bag large enough to carry an A4 sized folder. All Students will not be permitted to wear make-up or jewellery from September 2022 (including facial piercings and earrings).

From September 2022 all Year 7 to 11 students will also be required (as part of the Delta uniform), to wear plain black polishable shoes (no embellishments, logos, bows, markings or colours) no pumps, trainers, boots, canvas or patent shoes are allowed. Please do not purchase anything other than plain black polishable shoes as students will not be allowed to wear these in the Academy from September. Please see below for more images and information.

Students collecting GCSE results will be directed to the atrium for an appointment with the Key Stage/Sixth Form or Careers Team before leaving site.

If you cannot collect your results in person, you can nominate someone to collect them on your behalf. You must provide the name of the nominated person/s either in writing by handing a note directly to Mrs Jennifer Conroy before the end of the summer term or by email from the student's personal email not a parent or friend email to examsofficer@hansonacademy.org.uk Your representative will need to provide I.D. Alternatively you can provide a stamped self-addressed envelope and results will be sent in the post. Again, this must be provided before the end of the summer term. **Results will not be released to anyone other than the student without prior written permission from the student.** Information about the appeals process can be found on our website.

Travelling to school in September

Dropping off Students:

- In conjunction with West Yorkshire Police, we have been advised to inform parents/carers that it is **crucial** that students are dropped off or picked up from the **GOALS turning circle** at the beginning and end of the school day.
- If you are driving to the school, we would ask that you **do not use Sutton Avenue** to drop off or pick up or the main gate entrance as this will be dangerous for students walking to school. Exceptions will be made in cases of disability or if you are a visitor to the school.

Site Security:

In the interests of child safety and protection:

- Every morning all gates, entrances and exits will be locked at 8.30am (except for the main entrance on Sutton Avenue which remains accessible to visitors via the intercom/security). Please ensure that your child gets to school in good time in order to be able to access the site.
- The Principal, the Leadership and Pastoral Teams will welcome the students every morning at the blue line as they arrive and we say goodbye every afternoon as students leave through the main, Goals and bottom gate exits. Please note only the front entrance is accessible during the school day.
- At the end of the school day entrances and exits will be opened at 2.30pm.
- All staff and Sixth students are required to wear their lanyards at all times (including any non uniform days).

As the school is approaching the end of the academic year, it is important that you are clear about the arrangements for the beginning of the next academic year. We are looking forward to the new academic year all the opportunities it brings.

In closing, I would like to thank you again for your welcome and support. Together we can improve outcomes and opportunities for all our students.

School Shoes
